Sagaponack Common School District Annual Budget Vote & Election Voter Information

Eligibility

To be eligible to vote at the Sagaponack Common School District you must be registered. In order to register an individual must be:

- 1. A U.S. citizen,
- 2. At least 18 years of age,
- 3. Be a resident of the Sagaponack Common School District for a period of 30 days prior to the Annual Budget Vote and Election or Special School Board Meeting in which an individual offers to vote, and
- 4. Not claim the right to vote elsewhere

ABSENTEE BALLOTS

Applications for absentee ballots for election of school board members and for voting on the school budget are to be completed on a form prescribed by the State Board of Elections and may be obtained by visiting the New York State Education Department's Website (in English or Spanish) or by contacting the District Clerk by email at clerk@sagaponackschool.com or by telephone at 631-537-0651. Completed applications must be received at least seven (7) days before the election if the ballot is to be mailed to the applicant, or the day before the election if the ballot is to be delivered personally to the applicant or to his or her designated agent. Absentee ballot applications will not be accepted by the District Clerk before April 19, 2021.

MILITARY VOTERS

Pursuant to Education Law §2018-d, any person serving in the military, including spouses and dependents, may register to vote in the upcoming school district election. A military voter who is a qualified voter of the school district may obtain an absentee ballot application by contacting the District Clerk by phone (631-537-0651), email (clerk@sagaponackschool.com), mail (Jeanette Krempler, District Clerk, Sagaponack CSD, P.O. Box 1500, Sagaponack, NY 11962), or in person at 400 Sagg Main Street, Sagaponack, NY 11962 (during regular office hours or between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m.). A military voter who is duly registered may apply for a military ballot by requesting an application form from the District Clerk. Completed applications must be personally delivered or mailed to the District Clerk and received no later than 5:00 p.m. on **April 22**, **2021**. Completed military ballots must be received by 5:00 p.m. on **May 18**, **2021** if signed and dated by the military voter and one witness thereto with a date which is not later than the day before the election, or not later than the close of the polls on **May 18**, **2021** if postmarked or endorsed by an agency of the United States government. A military voter may designate a preference to receive a military voter registration form, military ballot application or military ballot by mail, facsimile or electronic mail in the request for such registration, ballot application, or ballot.

VOTING

The 2021 Annual School Board Budget Vote and Election will be held on Tuesday, May 18, 2021 from 7:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. (1 hour), at the Sagaponack Common School District, 400 Sagg Main Street, Sagaponack, NY 11962.

ELECTION OF BOARD MEMBERS

One (1) member of the Sagaponack CSD Board of Trustees will be elected for one (1) term of three (3) years commencing July 1, 2021 and expiring on June 30, 2024. Last incumbent, Lauren Thayer.
